High school budget: passed

BCA: we are still waiting for the band monies to be released by the BCA. Delay is due to confusion about how much money the band actually has in the BCA account, because the BCA treasurer is trying to sort out all accounts for the last 2 years.

M. Ofsonka will send a letter to Michelle Davis, BCA treasurer, requesting the funds, with a statement that if there is a discrepancy, the BCA has until December 31, 2008 to notify her.

Credit cards: too many people have access to the Band Booster credit card number. This is resulting in money being spent without researching the best price. M. Mutchler suggested a meeting between Gay. Van Beek, Alan Johnson, Tracy Magwire, and Marianne Ofsonka and her to discuss.

General Band Booster Meeting: In addition to above, Terri and James Walker, Danielle and Paul Hough, Buzz and dee dee Collins, and Larry Weeks were in attendance.

FOSCB: dee dee Collins has a file of what was done in the past and she will share it with the Walkers, who agreed to head up FOSCB. Discussion around sending the information to Band Boosters electronically or in a paper packet:

- electronic: cheaper but do people read e-mails and will they print out the paper?
- Paper packets: could have available at the Nov. 12 concert with a follow up e-mail, but paper is expensive.

Motion made, seconded, and carried that 20% of FOSCB funds raised by a particular student will go to student account, 80% will go to General Band Booster Account.

3. Homecoming parade: D. Hough will coordinate
4. Marching Stallion Senior Dinner: deedeede will organize. This event will be NO HOST – families/ students are responsible for their own costs.
5. Fall concert Nov. 12. K. and J. Brown will coordinate volunteers and refreshments. Deedeede will design programs. M. Mutchler will copy and staple the programs.
6. Pie Sale: starts 10/6; pickup on 11/13. Packets will be distributed Monday and Tuesday, 10/6 and 7. Color Guard is invited to sell pies if they'd like. M. Ofsonka and J. Ervin are coordinating.
7. Concert Uniforms: D. Hough is in charge. Parents are needed to measure MS students, who meet 6th and 7th period. A. Johnson needs the number of cummerbunds and bow ties that we have. D. Hough will count and get this information to Mr. J.
