I. Clarification of miscellaneous details with Alan

1. Winterguard

- * Reusing floor from last year

2. Drumline

- * No anticipated overnites this year, so far => radical cost reduction from last year
- * Need parent coordinator
- * Percussion equipment paid through school fees

3. Marching Band

- * Marianne still getting receipts.
- * Storage shed door replacement will go into MB band budget.
- * Busses for this Friday's Westfield game will be paid for by SCSS.
- * Add Misc Charge line item to cover entrance fee for seniors to final home game.
- * Uniform money in CD has been rolled over.
- * Will submit debt cards for students with unpaid fees.
- * Were JMU bus drivers tipped? If not, Marianne will remedy.
- * Need more garment bags next year.

IV. Etc.

- * Playoff game this Friday night. Mandatory attendance, wearing show shirts and Underarmor.
- * Extraneous vintage spirit wear will be sold at the concert.
- * MS uniforms ordered today; arriving Friday; to be distributed Fri-Tues. HS bands handed out this week.
- * Used uniforms already have cummerbund and bowtie in jacket pocket
- * Pie pick-up this Thurs; no confirmed volunteers yet; will take 1st eight student volunteers who show up.
