

## Earning Money for Band Students Just Got Easier!!!

SCSS Band Boosters are transitioning to a more automated feature of Great Lakes Scrip. Instead of filling out a paper copy, you will place your order online at Great Lakes Scrip and then drop off your payment check in the lockbox or mail it/drop it off with Sherry Feehs or Susan Dilbeck. Your order will not be placed unless you have provided the corresponding check for your order.

To Create a ShopWithScrip Account:

1. Go to <http://www.shopwithscrip.com/>
2. Select "**Create Account**" in the "Family Sign Up!" box (it's a green box on the left-hand side).
3. Fill out the requested information - not all of it is mandatory and then select "**I Accept**"
4. You will be prompted to select two password verification questions.
5. After this select "Manage Non-Profits" from left-hand list of options on your Family Home page. This is where you "Join" and have to enter the SCSS Band Boosters enrollment code: **972F1517127L4**
6. You are now ready to place your order. The "Express Add" is a handy feature; there is a User Guide to assist you located in the option list on the left-hand side of the page.
7. Scrip orders will still be placed twice a month around the 14th and 29th of each month.
8. Sherry Feehs will continue to distribute the gift cards and certificates once they have been shipped from Great Lakes.
9. ShopWithScrip also offers the ability to purchase ScripNow! There are only a few retailers participating; Amazon is one of the retailers participating. If you select this, once the whole order is authorized, you will receive an email at the account you entered in your ShopWithScrip profile notifying you that your ScripNow! orders are available. To retrieve your electronic gift cards (ScripNow!), log into your ShopWithScrip account, and select "ScripNow!" from the left-hand option list. From the Purchase History screen, select "view" to print out your electronic gift card or record the code to use online.
